Whereas, the Town of Long Lake recognizes the importance of enhancing its ability to mitigate the potentially devastating impacts of wildfire as well as the importance of reducing the human suffering, property damage, interruption of public services and economic losses caused by wildfire; and






Now, therefore be it resolved that:
