SETTING THE NUMBER OF ELECTION OFFICIALS FOR TOWN ELECTIONS AND  
ALLOWING THE TOWN CLERK TO ASSIGN ADDITIONAL ELECTION OFFICIALS AS  
NEEDED

The Town Board of the Town of Long Lake, Washburn County, Wisconsin, by this Resolution, adopted by a majority of the Town Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:


Whereas Section 7.32, WI statutes, allows a municipal governing body to reduce the required number of election officials at a polling place from 7 to not less than 3, and the town board has determined it would be advantageous to the town to have only as many election officials on duty as are needed for a given election.


Therefore, there shall be a minimum of three (3) election officials on duty at every election,


And therefore, at the discretion of the town clerk, the requisite number of election officials may be increased for any election. However, the number of election officials working at a given election shall always be an odd number.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under section 60.80 WI statutes.
